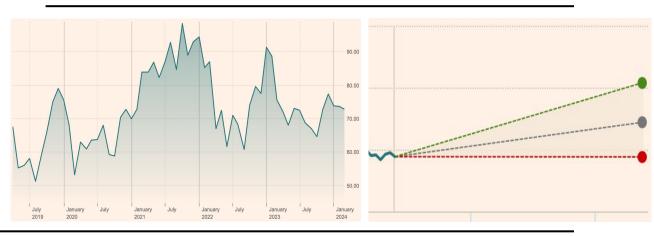

### **Competitive Landscape**

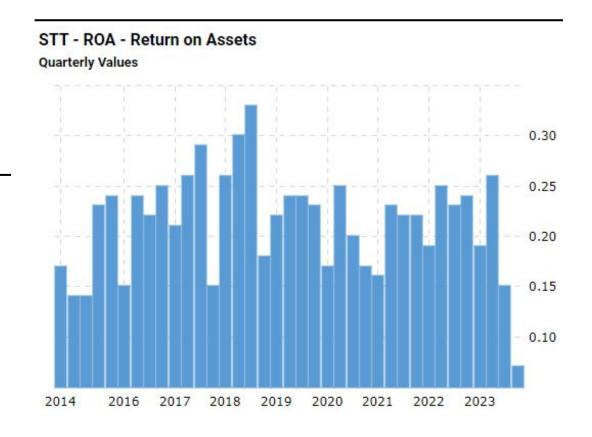

- Clean record of little/no financial scandals; strong reputation

- Equity buyback off \$500 million worth of shares

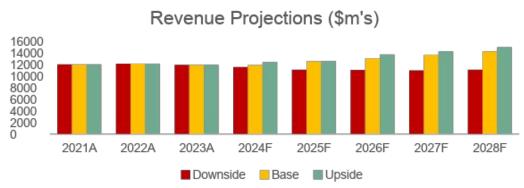
#### Methodology:

- Downside take average of management fees/ servicing fees in past 3 years
- Base Assume growth rate 4% -
- Best Assume growth rate 6% Tap into thematics, alternative investments (high returns on assets, strong macroeconomic environment.
- Best: \$86, Base: \$81, Worst \$64

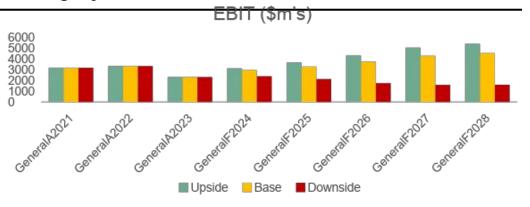

### Q1 2024 Earnings Release and Dividend Announcement:

STT is scheduled to announce its financial results for the first quarter of 2024 on April 12, 2024.

- Historically, Q1 earnings are lower compared to the other quarters
- Q2 2024 earnings expect EPS to increase by 30%



#### **Interest Rates:**

Changes in interest rates can impact State Street's net interest margin (NIM).

- Federal Reserve expected to cut interest rates in 2024
- Headline inflation only 1.2% away from Federal Reserve's 2% target



#### **Market Conditions:**

Market growth or downturns directly impact State Street's Assets Under Management (AUM).

- Corporate M&A dealmaking is expected to increase by 12% in 2024
- Provides the corporation with better acquisitions to improve company performance
